Historic Boston

3 Days October 22-24, 2024

Day 1 – Florence Griswold Art Museum – Boston, MA –

Today, board your deluxe Starr Tours Motorcoach and begin travel to Boston, MA. First stop today is in Old Lyme, CT at the Florence Griswold Art Museum. Florence Griswold opened her timeworn family home to artists searching for a quiet country retreat where they could rejuvenate their spirits and find sources of inspiration. The group was known as the Lyme Art Colony and Miss Florence’s boardinghouse became the center of Impressionism in America. To honor Miss Florence and the Colony, the Florence Griswold Museum was established and has flourished in exciting ways. Enjoy lunch on your own at the Café Flo located at the museum.

Arrive in Boston, MA this afternoon and check into the Hilton Boston Park Plaza for a two-night stay. This premier Back Bay location, surrounded by shopping, dining and entertainment. Boston Common and the Public Gardens are steps away while Beacon Hill and the Theatre District are within a half mile. Tonight, dinner is included at Maggiano’s Little Italy. **(D)**

Day 2 - Driving Tour of the Freedom Trail – Quincy Market & Faneuil Hall – Boston Tea Party Ship & Museum w/ Tea Tasting -

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel this morning, before meeting your local costumed Step on Guide for a Riding Tour of Freedom Trail. Today’s tour will include Boston Common, The State House, Granary Burying Ground, King’s Chapel Burying Ground, Old South Meeting House, Old State House, site of Boston Massacre and Faneuil Hall.

During the tour you will experience three 20-minute stops at the Granary Burying Ground, The North End and The Bunker Hill Monument. This tour will end at Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall where you can enjoy lunch on your own at one of the many restaurant options.

The afternoon features a visit to the Boston Tea Party Ship & Museum. Relive the events of December 16, 1773 with Paul Revere and patriots in a live re-enactment of the Boston Tea Party.

You’ll “meet” Sam Adams, dump tea from decks of a replica ship, the Beaver II and visit the tea themed gift shop! Costumed guides spin intriguing tales of 18th century sea stories. Tea Party Museum designed to not only commemorate the fateful event but also to allow visitors to relive it. The museum features replicas of the three merchant vessels boarded by patriots, the Beaver, the Eleanor, and the Dartmouth, as well as movie studio quality exhibits featuring a virtual Samuel Adams and King George III. A tea tasting is included with your visit.

Return to your hotel to freshen up before dinner. Tonight, enjoy dinner at a local upscale/full service restaurant. **(B,D)**

Day 3 - Free Time & Shopping on Newberry Street – Hartford CT – Mark Twain House & Museum – Depart for Home -

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy some free time for shopping on Newberry Street. The famed Newbury Street shopping district in Boston's swanky Back Bay neighborhood is where you'll find internationally known designers such as Marc Jacobs, Chanel, and Ralph Lauren, trendy boutiques such as Pink, national retailers such as Rag & Bone, and local locally owned shops such as Betsy Janney, L'Elite, and Soodee.

Departing Boston, travel to Hartford, CT where you enjoy lunch at an upscale local eatery. Then take a guided tour of the Mark Twain House & Museum. The Museum has restored the author’s home, where the author and his family lived from 1874 to 1891. Twain wrote his most important works during the years he lived there, including Adventures of Huckleberry Finn, The Adventures of Tom Sawyer, and A Connecticut Yankee in King Arthur’s Court. Depart for home following your visit. **(B,L)**
